Business Intelligence is the collective term for skills, technology, applications and methods of a systematic and scientific nature which an organisation can use to better understand its business activities and its environment. Business Intelligence creates a learning environment which makes it possible for organisations and companies to run their activities more effectively and more intelligently.

Programme Content

To attain the knowledge necessary for success in this field, students study subjects such as decision-making systems, data modelling, experimental planning, geographical information systems, optimisation, prognosis, simulation and statistical inference, and understanding for business development and organisation during a period of two years.

Learning Outcomes

After two years on the Business Intelligence programme you will have the ability to develop new and original knowledge, create new ideas as you have received specialised theoretical and practical knowledge which for the most part is unique and is at the cutting edge of this field. You are independent and can handle business situations involving problem-solving where many factors interplay. In other words, you have learned to analyse the apparent chaos and identify what really is interesting and relevant. You will know how this should be communicated so that the information contributes to the organisation's development.

Future Prospects

All this will make you a very attractive prospect in the job market as you know how to collect, store, analyse and quality assure data. In addition, you are able to provide the right information at the right time to the right place. With your masters degree in Business Intelligence you have the qualifications to obtain a desirable employment in Dalarna, Sweden, Europe, or internationally.

- Land and water area: 31,351 km²
- Highest point: Storvätteshågna, 1.2 km² above sea level.
- Lowest point: where the river Dalälven runs out of the region in the south east, 55 metres above sea level.
